## Report on actions taken by the Rhode Island Ethics Commission in Executive Session held on March 22, 2022:

1. Upon motion made and duly seconded, it was unanimously voted (6-0) to approve the minutes of the Executive Session held on March 8, 2022.

[Reporter's Note: Commissioner Jones was not present during Executive Session.]

2. Unanimously voted (6-0) in the matter of <u>In re: Stephen P. Mattscheck</u>, Complaint No. 2022-1, to initially determine that the Complaint states facts that, if true, are sufficient to constitute a violation of the Code of Ethics and authorized an investigation.

An Initial Determination is a preliminary vote that should not be construed as an opinion regarding the truth of the facts alleged in the complaint but is merely a vote to conduct an investigation into the allegations raised.

3. Unanimously voted (6-0) to return to Open Session.
