

**Report on actions taken by the Rhode Island Ethics Commission
in Executive Session held on April 26, 2022:**

1. Unanimously voted (5-0) to approve the minutes of the Executive Session held on March 22, 2022.
2. Unanimously voted (5-0) in the matter of **In re: Richard Nassaney, Complaint No. 2022-2**, to initially determine that the Complaint states facts that, if true, are sufficient to constitute a violation of the Code of Ethics and authorized an investigation.

An Initial Determination is a preliminary vote that should not be construed as an opinion regarding the truth of the facts alleged in the complaint but is merely a vote to conduct an investigation into the allegations raised.

3. Unanimously voted (5-0) to return to Open Session.
