- 1. Unanimously voted (6-0) to approve the minutes of the Executive Session held on December 10, 2024.

Unanimously voted (6-0) in the matter of <u>In re: Anastacia Williams</u>, Complaint No. 2024-11, that there does not exist probable cause to believe that the Respondent, Anastacia Williams, a 2024 candidate for the Rhode Island House of Representatives, violated R.I. Gen. Laws §§ 36-14-16 and 36-14-17 by not disclosing her position as Community Based Organizations Coordinator with the City of Providence Recreation Department on her 2023 Financial Disclosure Statement.
- 3. Unanimously voted (6-0) in the matter of **In re: Michael DeFrancesco**, Complaint No. 2024-13, to determine that the matter was moot in light of the Respondent coming into immediate and full compliance with the Financial Disclosure Mandate.
- 4. Unanimously voted (6-0) to return to Open Session.
