Hoyle, Jr., the former Building Official for the Town of Tiverton, violated Rhode Island General Laws § 36-14-16 by failing to file a 2024 Financial Disclosure Statement with the Rhode Island Ethics Commission.
- 3. Unanimously voted (8-0) in the matter of <u>In re: Jonathan Pascua</u>, Complaint No. 2025-2, to grant the Prosecution's Motion to Enlarge Time for Investigation, First Extension by 60 days to December 21, 2025.
